Fully Informed Children

Aims

- Have gained ideas about making their setting inclusive to all children

- Have an increased understanding of methods to make settings inclusive
- Share good practice

The session will also include practical demonstrations of techniques

- Understand the importance of and obligation for sharing information with young disabled children.
- Understand and begin to address the barriers facing professionals working with young disabled children.
- Begin to identify information sharing practices within their own organisation.
- Identify methods of making early years settings more inclusive.
- Understand the effectiveness of certain mediums when working with children.
