#### **In The Picture**

This practical workshop introduces the work of the project and looks at examples of good practice in including all children via children's books, toys and games. It also looks at methods to make your setting more inclusive.

#### **Aims**

By the end of the session delegates will:

- Have a greater knowledge of the work of In The Picture
- Have an increased knowledge of the importance of inclusive resources for young [and disabled] children
- Have gained ideas about making their setting inclusive to all children

#### **The session will:**

- Give a summary of the work of the project, its successes and aspirations for the future
- Examine the role disabled children have played in literature in the past and their ideas for the future
- Increase awareness of existing resources – particularly books, toys and games that include all children.
- Increase the understanding of methods to make settings inclusive

The session will also include a demonstration of some of the existing resources for young children.

#### **Projected Learning Outcomes**

- Understand the importance of including images of disabled children in story books and the work of the project in this area
- Increased knowledge of resources already available
- Identify methods of making early years settings more inclusive
- Understand the effectiveness of certain mediums when working with children
